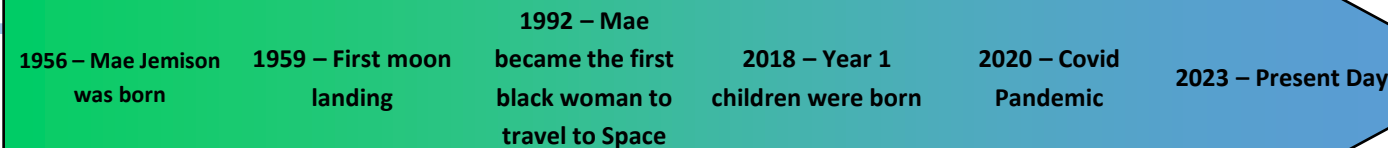
Mae Jemison

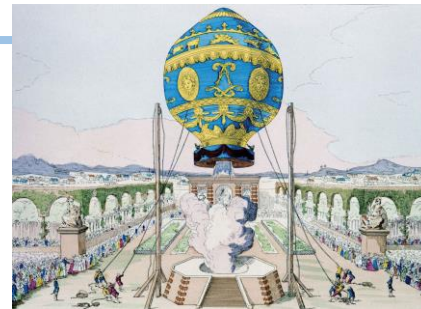

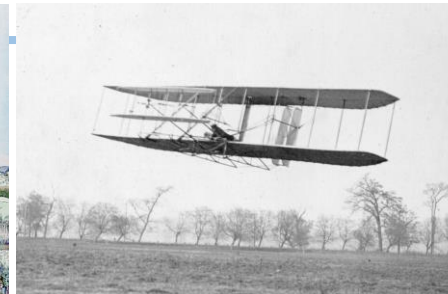

- In 1793 the Montgolfier brothers took the first flight in a hot air balloon

- Amelia Earhart - first female to fly across the Atlantic and Bessie Coleman, the first female black pilot.
- Orville and Wilbur Wright invented the aeroplane
- Today people can take trips that would have taken months by train or boat, now taking a few hours by plane.

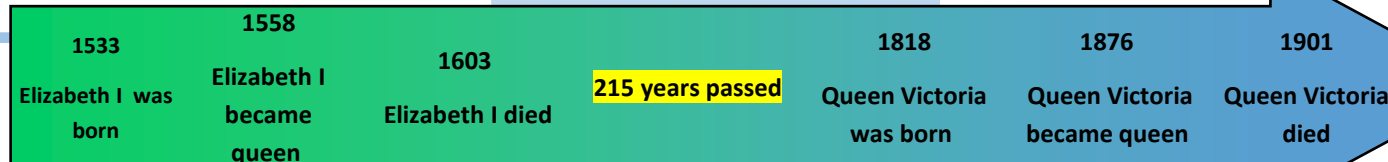
Queen Elizabeth I

KEY LEARNING

- A monarch is a king or queen who rules over a country until they die or give up the throne.
- In the UK, the heir to the throne is the King or Queen's eldest son.
- Today, the monarch does not have as much power as they used to.
- Elizabeth I ruled for 45 years
- She was the last monarch in the Tudor times.
- Queen Victoria was only 18 when she became the queen.
- Queen Victoria was the first British ruler to travel on a train, use a telephone and switch on electric lights.
- The time that Queen Victoria ruled was known as the Victorians times.
